"The Great Utah Get-Together" returns June 19-22, 2025, a community celebration of art: visual, music, dance, film, literary, and more. Headlining Musical Acts

Leftover Salmon kicks off the festival on Thursday, June 19, bringing their pioneering jamgrass sound to the Festival Stage. For over 30 years, this legendary Colorado ensemble has been at the forefront of the progressive bluegrass movement, seamlessly blending traditional bluegrass with rock, folk, and Cajun/Zydeco influences. Their high-energy performances have earned them a reputation as one of America's most beloved festival acts.

On Friday, June 20, **Robert Randolph** brings his virtuoso pedal steel mastery to the Festival Stage. Music legends including Beyonce, Elton John, Eric Clapton, Metallica, and Dave Matthews have incorporated Randolph's unique sound into their own recordings. With four Grammy nominations and listed on Rolling Stone's "100 Greatest Guitarists of All Time," his work can be heard on numerous TV and film broadcasts, including the current theme song for NFL Thursday Night Football.

Souls of Mischief headlines Saturday night, June 21, celebrating the enduring influence of their groundbreaking hip-hop. The Oakland quartet's innovative lyricism and jazz-influenced beats have inspired generations of artists. Their performance promises to demonstrate why they remain one of hip-hop's most respected groups, seamlessly blending old-school authenticity with contemporary relevance.

Closing the festival on Sunday, June 22, Latin Grammy-nominated **MV Caldera** brings her artistry to the stage. This Venezuelan songwriter, musician, and producer showcases the dynamic evolution of contemporary Latin music, drawing from her extensive classical training and diverse performance background at venues from Radio City Music Hall to the United Nations.
